

Confession Scriptures (July 24, 2010)

Colossians says we're qualified to receive "the inheritance of the saints..." "...giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. (Colossians 1:12)" What is that inheritance? Our inheritance is every promise of God for the New Testament believer.

These scriptures aren't all-encompassing, but they're at least a start. Highlight them in your Bible, confess them over yourselves, and use them to encourage others.

I have intimacy with God: "...for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me, and have believed that I came forth from God. (John 16:27-28)"

I have everything I need that pertaining to life and living for God: His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue (2 Peter 1:3)

My actions reflect the nature of God: But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. (Galatians 5:22-24)

The Holy Spirit is leading and teaching me: However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come. (John 16:13)

I've been freed from sin: ...knowing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin. (Romans 6:6-7)

I'm alive, forgiven, and made right with God: And you, being dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses, having wiped out the handwriting of requirements that was against us, which was contrary to us. And He has taken it out of the way, having nailed it to the cross. (Colossians 2:12-14)

I may be young, but God will give me wisdom when I ask: If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. (James 1:4-5)

God's truth continues to work in me: For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe. (1 Thessalonians 2:13)

My prayers are answered: "And in that day you will ask Me nothing. Most assuredly, I say to you, whatever you ask the Father in My name He will give you. Until now you have asked nothing in My name. Ask, and you will receive, that your joy may be full. (John 16:23-24)

God's protecting me: For He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, lest you dash your foot against a stone. You shall tread upon the lion and the cobra, the young lion and the serpent you shall trample underfoot. (Psalms 91:11-13)

I always overcome the work of the enemy: And this is the spirit of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world. You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world. (1 John 4:3-4)

I am redeemed from the curse of the law (Read Deuteronomy 28 to see the blessings and the curses from the law): Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"), 14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith. Galatians (3:13-14)

My life is "in Jesus," who is my wisdom, sanctification, and redemption: But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God — and righteousness and sanctification and redemption — 31 that, as it is written, "He who glories, let him glory in the Lord." (1 Corinthians 1:30-31)

I hear and understand God's voice: And when he brings out his own sheep, he goes before them; and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice... (John 10:4)

There's no part of me that lack's—I've been made complete: For in Him dwells all the fullness of the Godhead bodily; 10 and you are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power... (Colossians 2:9-10)

Nothing can separate me from God's love: For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, 39 nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39)

Christ has enriched me in every way: ...you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge (1 Corinthians 1:5)

Everything I set my hand to prospers: Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night. He shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever he does shall prosper. (Psalms 1:1-3)

I'm enriched financially so I can be a blessing to God's purposes: Now may He who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness, 11 while you are enriched in everything for all liberality, which causes thanksgiving through us to God. (2 Corinthians 9:10-11)

Jesus carried my sickness and threw away my disease: When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses. (Matthew 8:16-17)"
